**Addendum 01

Pepper Geddings Pool Deck**

The purpose of this Addendum 01 to RFP 22-R0006 for Pepper Geddings Pool Deck, dated July 28, 2021, is to list the key points of discussion from the mandatory pre-proposal site visit.

- All Offerors are encouraged to visit the Mary C. Canty Recreation Center pool (971 Canal Street, Myrtle Beach, SC 29577.) This will be a reference point for both color and finished product expectations.
- When visiting facilities, please announce your presence and intentions to the front desk staff. Please be mindful of programs and meetings that may be occurring at the time of your visit.
- Offerors are responsible for their own measurements.
- Offeror will be responsible to remove existing deck down to a good base to put down new material.
- Offeror will be responsible to remove existing brick and then apply floor paint that continues for eight (8) inches (height of bricks) up the cinder block wall, door jambs, and around support columns. This measurement is a correction from the previously published specification of twelve (12) inches.
- Offeror is to remove all hardware (ladders, handrails, etc.) and then reinstall the exact same equipment when project is complete. If an item is damaged due to Offeror fault, then the Offeror will be responsible to replace it. If an item is damaged because of long-standing deterioration (rust, must be sawed off to remove, etc.) then the City will be responsible to replace it.
- Offeror is to remove existing starting blocks and replace with new starting blocks that will be provided by the City.
- The City will be responsible for removing loose items from the existing pool deck.
- The water level in the pool will be lowered. Offeror is responsible for preventing deck materials from contaminating pool water.
- Performance period will begin on November 1, 2021 and all work must be completed by January 1, 2022. Working hours are from 7:00AM – 7:00PM, Monday through Saturday, excluding City holidays. Offerors are advised that there may be limited truck access during the hours of 3:00PM to 6:00PM each day due to the presence of students enrolled in the after school program.

- Additional questions are due no later than 12:00 noon (local time) on Monday, August 23, 2021. Questions may be submitted via e-mail to asowers@cityofmyrtlebeach.com. All questions received by the deadline will be answered via addendum.
- Sealed proposals are due in the Purchasing Office no later than 2:00PM (local time) on Tuesday, August 31, 2021. No e-mail submissions will be accepted. The City of Myrtle Beach is not responsible for late or misdirected mail.
- The mandatory conference sign-in sheet is attached and is hereby made part of this addendum.


