According to the in-force policy's Dec page, only 9-12 grade sports and extracurricular activities are covered which number 2,000 student athletes - see below.

Please confirm that this will remain the case for the 2017-18 school year.

## Bibb Responses - David Gowan June 27, 2017:

- We cover our high school male and female athletes only.
- The policy does give parents the ability to purchase individual student accident insurance for their student with different coverage options available.
- I submitted the student accident insurance loss runs for the last five years last Friday.
- We provide student accident insurance coverage for our high school athletes nor our middle school athletes.
- I double checked and we only cover the high school male and female athletes.
- Our policy does give parents or guardians the right to purchase an individual student accident insurance policy.
