- 1. What type of fuel was in the tanks? Regular automotive gasoline.
- 2. Are the tanks currently empty? The tanks were emptied but there may be residual fuel in the bottom.
- 3. What will the area be used for? Public viewing areas along Boundary Street.
- 4. Has there been any soil testing? The soil has been tested and no leaks were detected.
- 5. Has there been any assessment of the condition of the tanks? The city has not completed any assessment at this time.
- Is there an Environmental Consultant afterward to sample the ground? Include the cost in your bid.
- 7. What are the tank made of? Steel? Plastic? The make-up of the tanks is unknown.
- 8. Is there a time limit to finish the project? The target completion date is May 12th.
- 9. Is there a preference of removal or remediation? No preference. Cost is the deciding factor.
- 10. Are the pipes insulated? Unknown at this time.
- 11. Can the area be restored with asphalt rather than concrete? Yes, again, cost is the deciding factor.
- 12. Will compaction testing be required and if so at what frequency? WRT compacting. All DHEC regulations must be followed.
- Is there an on-site water source for cleaning and purging of lines? Water has been terminated at this site.
