This addendum will amend <u>Bid #22-035, Renovations & Additions to the Georgetown</u> <u>County Headquarters Library</u> originally issued on Friday, June 17, 2022. This clarification is being provided to all known and registered correspondents in response to questions received. On Wednesday, June 29, 2022, Georgetown County Purchasing and Library staff held a Mandatory public pre-bid conference and site inspection for the Renovations & Additions to the Georgetown County Headquarters Library on location in Georgetown, SC. Attached is a copy of the agenda from that meeting as well as a copy of the sign-in sheet. Only firms with a representative listed on the attached sign-in sheet will be allowed to submit a bid.

Question 1: What are the working hours?

Response: The standard hours of work will be 8 am - 6 pm. The library will remain open during the phase 1, building of the addition. Once that is completed and work moves to phase 2, the renovations of the existing library, it is anticipated that the library will need to be closed with the exception of the auditorium, which may be used to continue some library operations in combination of the book mobile.

Question 2:	Who is responsible for moving the furniture and shelving? Is shelving and other furniture included as part of the project?					
Response:	Section 01100 Summary, 1.3 A – The Owner will be responsible for the remova and relocation of all books.					
	The relocation / removal of existing furniture and shelving is part of the FFE allowance, and part of the base bid package. The FFE allowance amount is also for new furniture and new shelving, and this amount is part of the base bid package. We will address FFE selections after we have an awarded contractor in place.
