## **Questions Received:**

**Question #1:** Would shotcrete be an acceptable alternative lining method instead of the CIPP for the larger pipes?

**Response #1:** No, shotcrete is not an acceptable alternative lining method for this project.

**Question #2:** Are you allowing UV Cure CIPP? It is a much stronger product without the contaminated water used in water cured lining.

Response #2: UV curing is an acceptable alternative to water curing for this project. However, the contractor will have to provide liner thickness design calculations sealed by a Tennessee registered professional engineer as part of the preconstruction submittal material for approval by the city of Knoxville Engineering Department.

**Question # 3:** The invitation to bid references a Drug Free affidavit but we cannot find that in the document.

**Response #3:** Attached please find a revised Submission Affidavits and Certifications form BD-28 through BD-30 which hereby replaces the previous form.
