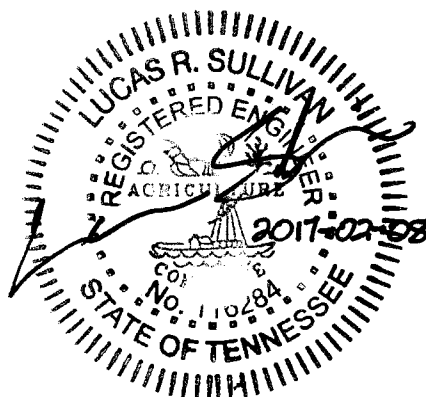

1. Introductions

2. Project Scope/Description

- a. The Project includes: the installation of approximately 12,300 feet of cured-in-place pipe lining (CIPPL) in gravity sanitary sewer mains, of which approximately 440 feet is 30-inch diameter, 4,380 feet is 24-inch diameter, 5,590 feet is 18-inch diameter, and 1,800 feet is 8-inch diameter, as well as pre-installation cleaning of all lines and pre- and post-installation closed-circuit television (CCTV) inspection of all lines; the installation of approximately 1,300 feet of CIPPL in sanitary sewer service laterals; the reinstatement of approximately 77 sanitary sewer service laterals by robotic means and 110 sanitary sewer service laterals by open-cut means; the rehabilitation of approximately 800 vertical feet of manholes utilizing cementitious lining and 1,840 vertical feet of manholes utilizing polymer resin-based lining; furnishing and installing approximately 113 chimney seal manhole inserts, 84 manhole inflow dish inserts, and 113 manhole frames and covers; the replacement of approximately 620 feet of 8-inch diameter gravity sanitary sewer mains via open-cut in the same trench; and approximately 71 point repairs, ranging in size from 8-inch to 24-inch diameter pipe.

- e. No Bid withdrawn within 120 calendar days of receipt of Bids.
- f. City will release addenda changing bidder identification form in specifications to one original with no copies.

5. Qualifications

- a. Refer to Section 00 21 13 Instructions to Bidders, and Section 00 45 13 Statement of Bidder's Qualifications
 - i. Bidder shall maintain permanent place of business
 - ii. Must be licensed by State of Tennessee to perform work under contract
 - iii. Bidder shall demonstrate adequate construction experience and sufficient equipment resources to properly perform work.
 - iv. Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if bidder fails to satisfy qualifications.

6. Bidding Requirements

- a. Bid Bond in the amount of 5% of Bid with Surety licensed to do business in TN and listed in U.S. Treasury Circular 570.
- b. No Bid withdrawn within 120 calendar days of receipt of Bids.
- c. Section 00 45 77 – Contractor's Identification must be completed, with one copy attached to the bid package.
- d. The Bidder shall submit one original of all documents in the envelope.

7. Bidder Questions and Addenda

- a. Use Section 00 21 14 – Request for Bidder Information. Submit by fax, email or mail to City of Chattanooga Purchasing Department. purchasing@chattanooga.gov.
- b. Questions received less than ten (10) days prior to the date for opening the Bids may not be answered.
- c. Required to purchase set of plans and specifications to get on the plan holders list. Only bidders on plan holders list will receive addenda; which must be acknowledged in the Bid Form. Addenda will be posted online as well.
- d. Requests for Information must be submitted by ~~February 9, 2017~~ **March 9, 2017**. Engineer will issue responses by ~~February 16, 2017~~ **March 16, 2017**.

8. Bid Opening

9. Contract Completion Time

10. Liquidated Damages

- a. \$500 for each day after Substantial Completion if work is deemed to not be substantially complete, and \$500 for each day after Final Completion if Contractor has not completed the work.

11. Project Specific Requirements

12. Site Access

- a. All work to be completed shall be on the City of Chattanooga's property or easements.
- b. If needed, the Contractor is responsible for acquiring all required right of entry and temporary construction easements on private properties in order to access existing sewers and perform the required work.
- c. If needed, Contractor is responsible for submitting all required permits needed for site access.

13. Safety

- a. Refer to Section 00 72 00 and 00 73 00 General Conditions

14. Work Hours

- a. Work Hour Restrictions – Work hours shall be 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. unless City has more specific restrictions.
- b. Contractor must give 24-hour notice and have written approval by the City to work outside hours.

15. DAVIS-BACON Act

- a. This project is being funded by a State Revolving Fund loan on or after 2010 EPA Fiscal Year. The loan recipient must be in compliance with all applicable requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act. Gina Ogle – Administrative Assistant, Southeast Tennessee Development District gogle@sedev.org
- b. Wages will be paid weekly
- c. Interviews to be conducted regularly by SETDD staff.
- d. When bidding, check wage rate sheets for correct categories for personnel.

16. Allowances

- a. The Contractor shall include in the Bid Total all allowances stated in the Contract Documents. These allowances shall cover the net cost of the services provided.

17. Other Items

- a. It is the Contractors responsibility to repair any existing utilities that are damaged during construction.
- b. The items discussed here today are not intended to be all-inclusive. It is the Contractor's responsibility to review the Contract Documents and comply with all provisions.
