This addendum is being released to address the following questions.

- 1. How will coordination occur between the Existing City drainage project, and this proposed sidewalk and resurfacing project, since they are both within the same project limits. Will this drainage project be complete prior to the NTP being issued for the Sidewalk and Roadway project.
 - All drainage items should have been covered under the previous contract and therefore removed from the current sidewalk bid. Due to construction sequence, the sidewalk will have to wait until the drainage inlets are set and aggregate base has been prepared. The NTP could be issued after all stormwater improvements are finished, or beforehand with American Sand & Asphalt serving as the schedule lead to coordinate block-by-block construction segments.
- Are delays expected due to any existing utility relocations that must occur prior to beginning this project? i.e. TECO Gas, Power, etc.
 Delays may be expected due to ongoing construction and the City may consider extending the contract for any delays during the construction.
- 3. Do we have to fill out the "List of five (5) references for similar type work with contact information."? We are doing a project with the city already.

 Yes, you still need to complete the references. This is a FDOT Lap funded project and the complete bid packet/invitation to bid still needs to be completed as indicated, in the bid packet.
- 4. The bid schedule does not have column for the unit price.
 We have corrected the Bid Tab-Basis for Bid adding a column for Unit Price. See attached Bid Form.



ARTICLE 1 - BID RECIPIENT

1.01 This Bid is submitted to:

1.02 The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 2 – BIDDER'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

2.01 Bidder accepts all of the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 90 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

ARTICLE 3 – BIDDER'S REPRESENTATIONS

- 3.01 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:
 - A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, and any data and reference items identified in the Bidding Documents, and hereby acknowledges receipt of the following Addenda:

- B. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and has satisfied itself as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings, and (2) reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
- E. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and any Site-related

- reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder; and (3) Bidder's safety precautions and programs.
- F. Bidder agrees, based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and confirms that the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- I. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance and furnishing of the Work.
- J. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of this Article, and that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

ARTICLE 4 – BIDDER'S CERTIFICATION

4.01 Bidder certifies that:

- A. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation;
- B. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid;
- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and
- D. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 4.01.D:
 - 1. "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process;
 - "fraudulent practice" means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
 - 3. "collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and
 - 4. "Coercive practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.

ARTICLE 5 - BASIS OF BID

5.01 Bidder will complete the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the following price(s):

5.02 LUMP SUM

- A. Where payment for items is shown to be paid for on a lump sum basis, no separate payment will be made for any item of work required to complete the lump sum item. The lump sum price bid for various items shall be compensation in full for furnishing all materials, labor, equipment, and incidentals with these plans and specification. All disposal costs shall be included in the bid items. Unless otherwise stated, measurement shall be based upon the Engineer's estimate of percent complete per partial payment period.
 - 1. Bid Item 3 Maintenance of Traffic (MOT): The <u>LUMP SUM BID AMOUNT</u> for all work included under this bid item will be made for any labor and materials required to successfully address Maintenance of Traffic during project construction. Contractor will refer to the MOT plans provided in the approved design plans. MOT shall include all those operations necessary to maintain traffic flow during hours of active construction and provide safe traffic operation conditions during off-hour scenarios. MOT items may include, but will not be limited to, FDOT-approved traffic cone placement concrete barricades, flag personnel, electronic signage, standard signage, temporary pavement markings and detour route planning. The LUMP SUM BID AMOUNT shall be based on the percentages of work completed as approved by the ENGINEER.
 - 2. **Bid Item 4 Clearing and Grubbing (Includes Landscaping Shrubs)**: The <u>LUMP SUM BID AMOUNT</u> will be a payment for successfully clearing and grubbing any areas within the project limits which prevent construction due to vegetative growth or landscaping. This includes, but is not limited to, all tree and shrub removal, equipment operated stump removal, chainsaw operation, excavation associated with vegetation removal, manual soil removal, manual removal of vegetation overgrowth and associated costs with equipment operation/maintenance. Seventy percent (70%) of the lump sum price will be payable with the first month's partial payment. The remaining thirty (30%) will be payable with the final partial payment.
 - 3. Additional Bid Item Mobilization and General Conditions: The LUMP SUM BID AMOUNT for all work included under this bid item will be made for mobilization and demobilization of all labor, equipment, materials and appurtenances necessary for construction of the project. Mobilization shall include all those operations necessary for the movement of personnel, equipment, supplies, and incidentals to the initial project site, safety equipment and first aid supplies, and sanitary and other facilities. Also included as part of this bid item is the cost for project performance and payment bonds, insurance, indemnifications, photographs, shop drawings, working drawings, schedules, documents, coordination, and phasing and other miscellaneous items associated with the work. Measurement for this bid item will be lump sum. The lump sum price for general provisions will be limited to five percent (5%) of the contract amount. Seventy percent (70%) of the lump sum price will be payable with the first month's partial payment. The remaining thirty (30%) will be payable with the final partial payment.
