PROCUREMENT FOR: Choppee Window Replacement Project-Phase I

This addendum will amend <u>Bid #22-032 REBID, Choppee Window Replacement Project-</u> <u>Phase I</u> originally issued on Wednesday, September 28, 2022. This clarification is being provided to all known and registered correspondents in response to questions received. All addenda and original bid documents are also available online at: <u>www.gtcounty.org</u>, select "Bid Opportunities" from the Quick Links section.

On Tuesday, October 4, 2022, Georgetown County Purchasing and Parks and Recreation staff held a public pre-bid conference and site inspection for the Choppee Window Replacement Project-Phase I onsite in Georgetown, SC. Attached is a copy of the agenda from that meeting as well as a copy of the sign-in sheet and some pictures of the interior and exterior windows that were taken during the pre-bid meeting

Question 1: What is the lead time for this project?

Response: There are places on the mandatory bid submittal for the vendor to provide their lead time for this project. Of course, we would like this work started and completed as soon as possible.

Ouestion 2: Can our subs come back to take additional measurements? Yes, just please coordinate that with Purchasing at least 24 hours in advance **Response:** so that we can setup an appointment for someone to be available to meet them to provide interior access as needed. **Question 3:** What are the hours that we can work? Are there any hours that we can't work? The facility is in operation M-F by various tennants. County will make sure **Response:** all are aware of work schedule (provided by Contractor). **Question 4:** Do you have any plans of the building that you can provide to us? **Response:** The County has one hard copy set that can be viewed by bidders if needed. Please call Purchasing to schedule a time to come and view them. Question 5: Has there been any asbestos testing done? If so, was any asbestos found? Can you provide us with that report? **Response:** Asbestos testing was done when the building was remodeled in 2004-2005 but the report could not be found for us to attach to the bid/addendum. How far up do you want us to go? To the tile or all the way up? What material is **Question 6:** behind the tile that goes up to the roof? **Response:** During the pre-bid meeting, the Director of Parks & Recreation had advised by phone to go all the way up to the roof. However, after consultation with our Facility Services Manager, you can only go up to the tile, as the tile portion is supporting the roof. The material behind the tile is steel but should no longer be a factor since you will only be replacing the current glass windows and glass block portions. If going all the way up to the roof, what do you want us to do with the lights & **Question 7:** fire alarm items? **Response:** This is no longer applicable as you will not be going all the way up to the roof, only up to the tile portion. **Question 8:** Do you want any interior damage from window installation to be fixed by the vendor?

Response: Yes, the vendor will need to fix any interior and exterior damage caused by their removal and replacement of the windows.

- **Question 9:** Are the block windows to be removed as well? Can you please clarify what you want them replaced with?
- **Response:** Yes, replace the block windows and replace with non-opening storefront glass like at the recreation center next door.
- WINDOWS =Kawneer IR501 or equivalent hurricane impact window frames with
1 5/16 Low E Insulated impact glass / solarban 60 (vision) with 1
5/16 Low E Insulated impact glass / solarban 60 over black spandral
(top glass). Vendor is responsible for all measurements before
bidding.
- DOORS = Kawneer 350 IR or equivalent hurricane impact doors, 9/16 Solarban 60 Low E Impact Glass, 1686 concealed panic devices, 10" bottom rail, surface mounted class 1 door closures, offset pivots w/ 1 intermediate pivot. Vendor is responsible for all measurements before bidding.
- **Question 10:** You stated like at the Northwest Choppee Recreation Center next door, can you please provide the specs for the windows from that building?
- **Response:** See response to question #9 and pictures attached. Vendor to provide insulated non-operable windows as indicated in the bid document.

Question 11: Are there any preferred manufacturers for the windows and glass?

Response: No, any mentioned manufacturers is only to assist bidders with specs. The County is open to any equivalent manufacturers. The Georgetown County Purchasing Officer shall have sole and final decision authority as to whether the products proposed are equivalent.

Question 12: Is there an engineer's estimate? If so, how much?

Response: No, there is no engineers estimate.

Question 13: Is there any asbestos or lead abatement?

Response: See response to question #5.

Question 14: What window configuration is requested? Fixed, double hung, picture, operable, etc.?

Response: See original bid document and response to questions #9 & #10.

- ADDITIONAL: See additional drawings attached which include replacement of front doors. Please use the attached revised bid submittal page which includes an add/alternate #1 for the replacement of the front doors with storefront doors.








Exterior View of Choppee Windows to be replaced.


