## PLANNING DEPARTMENT

1. **Comment** – Are Bidders to include removal and resetting of the HVAC condensing unit for installation of dimpled 30mil membrane to building foundation?

**Response** – *No, the AC unit is between the proposed border curb and the existing building in the area where there will be #57 stone.*

2. **Comment** – Drawing 4 – Permeable Paving Detail PICP Pavement Adjacent To Building: Please clarify approximate height of dimpled 30mil membrane from building foundation to subgrade of #4 stone.

**Response** - *From the bottom of the #4 stone base to the top of concrete permeable paver is approximately 15 inches high.*

3. **Comment** – Drawing 4 Permeable Paving Detail PICP Pavement: Are Bidders to include geotextile filtration fabric as shown by this detail?

**Response** – *No, Geotextile Fabric is not required on this project.*

4. **Comment** – Can you provide the Geo Report?

**Response** – *Yes, see attachment.*

5. **Comment** – Do they want No.87 stone or No. 89 stone?

**Response** - *#87 stone is preferred, but the specifications will allow #89 stone if #87 stone is not locally available.*

6. **Comment** – What area's require soldier course?

**Response** -*Solider course is required along the building face and border curb.*

7. **Comment** – Are the specs on the Dimpled Membrane, Expansion Material, Weed Barrier, & Impermeable Liner?

**Response** -*A. Dimpled Membrane- not required  
B. Expansion Material-½"x 6"flat expansion, joint material-charcoal color.  
C. Weed Barrier- Polypropylene Grade ultimate 20year life.  
D. Impermeable Liner- 30 mil/PSC liner w/803 nonwoven protective geotextile.*
