Addendum #2 Williamson County Community Development Multi-Modal Plan Due August 15, 2024, 2:00 p.m.

Williamson County has received the following questions:

• How do you anticipate the consultant team incorporating the NEPA findings?

We forwarded this question to our liason with the FHA and were told that since this is only a planning effort, the NEPA class of action will be a categorical exclusion under 23 CFR 771.117(c)(1), essentially excluding this project from detailed environmental analysis. With that being said, since there won't be any environmental analysis, I do not expect that there will be any NEPA findings for the consultant to consider in the planning process.

• Is it a requirement to respond to both the Safety Action Plan and the Multimodal Master Plan RFQ's or can a firm submit a qualification response to just the Multimodal Master Plan?

It is not a requirement to respond to both RFQ's.

• If a firm responds to just the Multimodal (Greenway) Master Plan should the envelope containing the response for qualifications still be marked "Statement of Qualifications, Safety Action Plan – Community Development" or a different title?
