GENERAL:

Question #1: *Could Sulzer be considered for the Vertical Turbine Pumps (43 21 47) on this project?*

Response: "Or equal" products shall be considered during the submittal phase.

Question #2: *Could Universal Blower Pac be considered for the Positive Displacement Blower Packages (43 11 33.13) on this project?*

Response: "Or equal" products shall be considered during the submittal phase. Note that per Section 43 11 33.13 Paragraph 1.04 B., "The blower package shall be furnished by the manufacturer of the blower itself to ensure single source responsibility for blower performance and compatibility of associated accessories. Blower packages that utilize blowers not specifically manufactured by the blower package suppliers themselves are not acceptable."

Question #3: *Could Valmatic be considered for the Plug Valves (Section 40 05 62) and Butterfly Valves (Section 40 05 64) on this project?*

Response: "Or equal" products shall be considered during the submittal phase.

Sealed Bids for the construction of the indicated project will be received by Davie County, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read at that time and location. All Bids submitted shall include all required documents as listed in Section 00 20 00 Instructions to Bidders. Bids must be submitted on the printed form, or exact copies thereof, contained in the Contract Documents.

The Work is primarily located in Cooleemee, NC on a site adjacent to the existing Cooleemee WTP site (located at 246 Main Street, Cooleemee, NC 27014), and consists of the following:

- A 16-inch raw water transmission main extending from the existing Primary Raw Water Pump Station to the new Cooleemee Water Treatment Plant.
- Upgrades to the existing Primary and Secondary Raw Water Pump Stations (new pumps, piping, and electrical facilities).
- Greenfield Cooleemee Water Treatment Plant with the following facilities:
 - Conventional surface water treatment process facilities (rapid mix, flocculation, sedimentation, filtration)
 - Ultraviolet reactors (duty/standby) for multiple barrier pathogen disinfection
 - Dual-cell clearwell

- High Service Pump Station equipped with duty/standby High Service Pumps and a duty Backwash Supply Pump
- Chemical storage and feed building
- Backwash equalization tank
- Administration building including offices and a process laboratory
- Miscellaneous yard piping
- Standby generator
- Demolition of the existing Cooleemee WTP
- Construction of 12-inch and 16-inch water mains along Main Street, Gladstone Street, and Hwy 601 including fittings and valves, fire hydrants, bore and jack trenchless crossings, and erosion and sedimentation control and other miscellaneous restoration

The Work will be financed by the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF # WIF 2018) and by the Economic Development Administration (Award Number is 04-01-07635). Bidder shall make positive efforts to use small and minority-owned businesses and comply with NC Division of Water Infrastructure MBE/WBE requirements and GS 143-128. The contracted bidder shall comply with federal AIS and Davis Bacon requirements throughout the project.

Bids will be received for a **SINGLE** prime Contract. Bids shall be on a **LUMP SUM and UNIT PRICE ITEM** basis, with an additive Alternative Bid item as indicated on the Bid Form. The Contract Times for the Work are set forth in the Agreement.
