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Questions and Answers

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1. Question: Is foil-surfaced face base flashing (Veral) to be installed at areas where repair work is taking place? (both are roof drain and parapet wall locations). Is the repair of the selective blisters to match the exist roof membrane in color?

Answer: Yes, repairs are to match the existing roof system in material type and color.

2. Question: If Alternate No.1 is not accepted are any specific repairs included in the Base Bid at these Roof Areas?

Answer: Yes, Roof drains on roof areas U and V, total of four (4) will be repaired per Detail 5/R1.2.

3. Question: Is a plumber to be used and coordinate by the Contractor for the plumbing work at roof

Answer: Yes.

drains?

4. Question: Are all roof drain that are repair / replaced to be flood tested after repairs are completed?

Answer: Yes.

5. Question: Were roof cores taken?

Answer: No. Contractor to field verify core thickness or existing roof system as the Contractor

sees necessary to complete the repairs.

6. Question: Is a Contractor Warranty Required?

Answer: Yes, as listed in specification section 075216.

7. Question: What roof drain size is needed for replacement locations?

Answer: The Contractor is to confirm roof drain bowl size. Size changes at each location and

include 3", 4", etc. bowl.

8. Question: What roof drain size is needed for replacement locations?

Answer: The Contractor is to confirm roof drain bowl size. Size changes at each location and

include 3", 4", etc. bowl.

9. Question: Where is the laydown if the Alternate Work is accepted at McCracken MS?

Answer: Laydown will be at the rear of the building at the roof edge of Roof Area S. The loading

area through the chain link fence / gate adjacent to the basketball court can be used for dumpster / dump truck location while the aggregate is being removed. This will be further discussed at the preconstruction meeting with the low bid Contractor.

10. Question: Are the roof drains in the alternate scope of work to have new lead and flashing installed if

alternate is accepted?

Answer: Yes.

11. Question: Is the base flashing overlay at the alternate location to go up to the metal panels and receiver

or are the metal panels to be removed?

Answer: Overlay with no removal of the existing metal wall panels. Additional sheet metal skirt

flashing will be installed to conceal base flashing overlay fasteners.

I. SUBCONTRACTORS

- a. **Definition of Subcontractor**: A subcontractor is an entity who will perform work or render service to the prime contractor to or about the construction site pursuant to a contract with the prime contractor. Bidder should not identify sub-subcontractors in the spaces provided on the bid form but only those entities with which bidder will contract directly. Likewise, do not identify material suppliers, manufacturers, and fabricators that will not perform physical work at the site of the project but will only supply materials or equipment to the bidder or proposed subcontractor(s).
- b. Subcontractor Qualifications: Bidder must only list subcontractors who possess a South Carolina Contractor's license with the license classification and/or subclassification identified in the left column. The subcontractor license must also be within the appropriate license group for the work of the specialty. If Bidder lists a subcontractor who is not qualified to perform the work, the Bidder will be rejected as non-responsible.
- **c. Use of Own forces:** If under the terms of the Bidding Documents, Bidder is qualified to perform the work of a listed specialty and Bidder does not intend to subcontract such work but to use Bidder's

- own employees to perform such work, the Bidder must insert its own name in the space provided for that specialty.
- **d.** If bidder is awarded the contract, bidder will not be allowed to substitute another subcontractor in place of a subcontractor listed above unless approved by the Owner.
- **e.** Bidder's failure to identify a subcontractor or themselves to perform the work of a subcontractor specialty listed in the first column on the left will render the Bid non-responsive.

J. TIME OF CONTRACT PERFORMANCE AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

a) CONTRACT TIME

The Date of Commencement of the Work shall be established in a Notice to Proceed. Substantial completion of the Work shall be within (30) Calendar Days from the Date of Commencement. Substantial completion is subject to changes as provided in the Contract Documents.

b) LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

The Owner shall retain as Liquidated Damages the amount of \$300 for each Calendar Day the actual construction time required to achieve Substantial Completion exceeds the specified or adjusted time for Substantial Completion.

The Owner shall retain as Liquidated Damages the amount of \$300 for each Calendar Day the actual construction time required to achieve Final Completion exceeds 30 calendar days beyond awarded Substantial Completion.

K. AGREEMENTS

- a) Bidder agrees that this bid is subject to the requirements of the laws of the State of South Carolina.
- **b)** Bidder agrees that at any time prior to the issuance of the Notice to Proceed for this Project, this Project may be canceled for the convenience of, and without cost to, the Owner.

c) The Owner, employees, representatives, consultants, agents, etc. shall not be responsible for any bid preparation costs or charges of any type, if all bids are rejected or the Project is canceled for any reason prior to the issuance of the Notice to Proceed.
