MINOR PERMIT REVISION

Dear Mr. Steele:

This letter serves as a minor permit revision, assigned file number FLA010193-011-DWF, to the City of Crestview domestic wastewater permit, file number FLA010212-010-DWIP. This is in response to your request to remove portions of the existing Land Application System (R-001) whereby reducing its reuse capacity, specifically Fields A, B, C, D, F, and portions of Fields E and H, due to plans for construction of a new roadway that will follow along portions of Arena Road; see attached map. Additionally, existing monitoring wells MWB-7 and MWC-10 will be impacted by the roadway construction and will require removal. Existing compliance well MWC-11, which will no longer monitor a sprayfield, is proposed to be reclassified as a background well to replace MWB-7.

Based on the information presented (i.e., proposed roadway construction), it was determined that the specified portions of R-001 and monitoring wells MWB-7 and MWC-10 can be eliminated. R-001 sprayfield reuse capacity is reduced, as proposed, from 2.1 to 1.53 MGD AADF. MWB-11 is designated a background monitoring well.

Attached are a revised permit cover page and permit replacement pages 2R and 11R of 23 showing deletions as strikethrough and additions as underlined, revised DMR R-001 with the reuse capacity reduced to 1.53 MGD AADF, and a new DMR for the reclassified MWB-11.

In accordance with Permit Condition III.4, all piezometers and monitoring wells not part of the approved ground water monitoring plan shall be plugged and abandoned in accordance with Rule 62-532.500(5), F.A.C., unless future use is intended.

This letter, as well as replacement pages, shall be attached to, and become part of, permit FLA010193-011-DWIP. All other requirements in Permit FLA010193-010-DWIP and its expiration date remain unchanged.
