 - o Oral representations made at the pre-bid conference are not binding upon the County.
 - All Communications during the process must go through the Purchasing Office.
 - Any questions regarding the Scope of Work/Solicitation must be submitted via Vendor Registry for a formal response by the due date.
 - o Bid Bond required for Bid Submission
 - o Payment and Performance Bond required for the life of the contract.
 - o Only VDOT Prequalified Contractors can submit a bid.
 - SCC Registration is required for award but not for submission to the ITB.
 - o Business License may be required for award but not for submission to the ITB.
 - o Insurance checklist Requirement must be sent to Insurance Agent for verification of requirements.
 - o Bidder's tradesmen must be entered on Attachment A Price Schedule for each line item.
 - Bidder's hourly rate for position and equipment must be listed on the Bid Form.
 - o The Contract will go to the December or January Board for award.
 - This is a Prevailing Wage (PW) solicitation (Daniel Stern, PW Coordinator): The wage determination incorporated into the bid solicitation and related contract award establishes the wages rates and fringe benefit rates that DOLI has determined to be prevailing in a given area for a particular type of construction. The Contractor shall be required to pay wages in compliance with the PW determination and submit a certified wage report to the County every month.

We suggest that all bidders review the sample contract attached to the solicitation as early as possible, so no time is lost after the award.

- Tomeka turned over the meeting to the Project Officers for an overview of the Scope of Work. Project Officers explained the project and highlighted the work to be done.
 - o The County is seeking a qualified Contractor to furnish all labor, materials, and equipment for maintenance, repair, and rebuild of the lighting systems in Arlington County.
- Once the overview was completed, Tomeka reiterated the Question deadline date and the Bid due date.
