### QUESTIONS:

1. We have developed several Community Involvement Plans (CIP). These outline strategies my firm will take with, or on behalf of, the client city to engage the public throughout the contract period. This would have many but not all of the items identified in an Enterprise-Wide Communications Plan (EWCP). Is this an acceptable alternative? In other words, would we be automatically disqualified if we submitted a CIP in lieu of an EWCP?

<u>Answer:</u> This is the first ever endeavor on an Enterprise Wide Communication Strategy, therefore CCWA does not have a list of similar work from the past. We have a SLBE program as well.
