- B. CLARIFICATIONS TO THE PROJECT MANUAL:
- C. <u>CLARIFICATIONS TO THE PROJECT DRAWINGS:</u>
- 1. No formal SWPPP is required, but contractor is to install and maintain erosion control as shown on the plans.
- 2. Refer to the "Typical Section" on sheet C2. Omit the aglime surface and reduce the aggregate base course width to 10'.
- 3. Contractor is to provide an as-built survey upon completion.
- 4. RPD will remove the two existing trees closest to the path, near the bath house.

- 5. Concrete walk thickness is to be 5".
- 6. No new chain link gates are included in this project. Refer to the plan view on sheet C3 and disregard note 2.
- 7. Earthwork clarification:
 - a. The earthwork (cut and fill) amounts shown on the plans reflect the difference from existing ground elevations to proposed ground elevations. This is calculated for computing the volume of fill in the floodplain only. The volume includes topsoil, paving, and stone.
 - b. There will be haul-off to outside of the Levings Lake floodplain. The compensatory basin area is meant to balance the volume of fill placed by the new path above. This volume must leave the floodplain to maintain a net zero fill condition.
