IN THE MATTER OF AWARDING BIDS FOR ROAD SALT

WHEREAS, a public notice to bidders asking for sealed bids for "Road Salt" addressed to the Purchasing Department of Franklin County, Union, Missouri was published in the Washington Missourian in the July 24, 2019 edition, for receipt by August 13, 2019; and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation and consideration and the recommendation of the Highway Administrator, the Franklin County Commission awards the bid to the lowest and most responsive bidder, Champion Salt, LLC, for the term of September 1, 2019 through August 30, 2020.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bid of Road Salt is hereby awarded to Champion Salt, LLC and is hereby approved and the Presiding Commissioner is authorized to execute any and all necessary documents on behalf of the County of Franklin and such other documents, certificates and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Order, for and on behalf of and as the act and deed of the County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the County shall, and the officials, agents and employees of the County are hereby authorized and directed to, take such further action, and execute and deliver such other documents, certificates and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be provided to Champion Salt, LLC; Ron Williams, Highway Administrator; and Ann Struttmann, Purchasing Agent.
