This addendum is hereby incorporated into the Bid Documents for the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions and/or revisions to and shall take precedence over the original documents. Additions are indicated by <u>underlining</u>, deletions are indicated by <u>strikethrough</u>.

- 1. Will the Trilock material being demolished/removed be able to be left on site? or will the Contractor be responsible for hauling and paying for final disposal?
  - A: Contractor is responsible for hauling and paying for disposal.
- 2. Is there an area identified for contractor staging?
  - A: There is an area on the south end of the project currently identified and it is anticipated as work progresses that an additional area will be identified.
- 3. Will there be a final-asbuilt needed upon completion? Who is responsible for this?
  A: Yes, As-Built drawings are needed to close out the permits. The Contractor is to hire a Professional Land Surveyor to perform this task, please see Addendum No. 2 for further details.
- 4. Are there CAD files available to the Contractor?A: Yes, CAD files will be made available upon request.
- 5. Is there a required BID BOND FORM?
  - A: You may use any form that your bonding company provides. Payment and Performance Bond forms will be sent with Notice of Intent to Award if the successful Contractor's bid exceeds \$100,000.
- 6. All other items shall remain the same.

The Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum on the Bid Proposal Form.
