Questions and Answers

- Q1. Does the flat percentage % apply to both direct service claims <u>and</u> cost settlement amounts or just direct service claims?
- A1. The district is willing to consider either arrangement. It is acceptable to propose different percentages, one for fee for service only, and another to include both fee for service and cost settlement.
- Q2. What is the total reimbursement over each of the most recent three fiscal years that have been cost settled? Dollars should be broke out between interim payments and cost settlements, be net federal dollars (FMAP) only, and indicated whether or not Special Transportation was included in the reimbursement.
