- Whether companies from Outside USA can apply for this? (like,from India or Canada) Any legitimate business may submit a proposal so long as the business is licensed to operate in this country, state, Town or that would be an immediate condition if selected.
- 2. Whether we need to come over there for meetings? This is to be determined; however, an initial in person meeting may be expected.
- 3. Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside USA? (like, from India or Canada) This is for the vendor to demonstrate; but, the vendor must be licensed to conduct business in the country, state, Town see item #1.
- 4. Can we submit the proposals via email? No see RFP requirements.
- 5. Roughly how many full time employees does the Town of Summerville employ? 365-380
- Does Summerville utilize Active Directory and would a bridge such as ADFS be desired for Employee Access? We do use AD, but we do not desire to integrate AD. We would prefer to assign usernames/passwords.
- 7. With the understanding that with our Government CMS you are allowed unlimited users, do you have an initial count of how many users you'd like trained? 6
 - a. Follow up question, do you prefer onsite or virtual training for your team? This is to be determined; however, an initial onsite meeting may be expected followed by virtual meetings.
- 8. When using the requested applicant tracking functionality, we've found including Employee Onboarding has a significant return on investment. Would the Town of Summerville like to see this option as well? Yes, we would like to see this option.
- 9. Will the site: www.visitsummerville.com be earmarked to include in your web redesign project? No, www.visitsummerville.com is not included in this project.
- 10. Will the site: http://www.summervillepolice.com be earmarked to include in your web redesign project? No, www.summervillepolice.com is not included in this project.
- 11. Can you provide an estimated number of pages found within your employee intranet today? 2-3
- 12. Are you looking for website redesign only or you want an updated and user-friendly content management system as well? If yes, do you have a preference for a certain CMS, as we are planning to use Drupal Content Management System? From a technical perspective, do you have any concerns if the site is developed using Drupal? We do not have any issues with Drupal development.

- 13. Do you require onsite meetings during the project development or remote meetings/presentations are sufficient? Onsite meetings, followed by virtual meetings, may be expected.
- 14. How many forms are available in the current website which will be integrated in the new website as well? Do you anticipate these numbers changing with the redesign?

 Approximately 90 forms.
- 15. Please list all payment gateways which already exist or need to change, which will be integrated into the site? We use STRIPE, but we are open to other gateways.
- 16. How many CMS users and roles do you have today? Do you anticipate these numbers changing with the redesign? We currently have 5 Content Management System users: 3 full admins and 2 can only administer specific areas. We may add more specific area admins not exceeding 12.
- 17. Are there any features on the website which are not accessible to the front-end user but important to know for us, so that the project cost and time-frame can be derived accordingly? We do have an employee access section and would like an intranet as an option.
- 18. Could you please provide more details on League Signups and facilities rentals? What will be the backend functionality of this module? We would like to see a self-service citizen portal for league signups and facility rentals that shows availability, etc. We would also like to see an employee interface for management of the Parks & Rec department.
- 19. Who do you consider your competitive or aspirational peer websites? The Town is looking for a highly user friendly as in "3 clicks max to find content" if possible; mobile friendly; ADA compatible website.
- 20. What traffic are you expecting on the website, this will help us to share the best suggestions for the hosting services? Citizens, contractors, developers, economic development, permits, business licenses, sign ups, registrations, research.
- 21. What is your bandwidth consumption and how much hard drive space do you want? We currently are at 50M, probably need 1-2 TB.
- 22. Can you share the budget allocated for this project? The RFP specifically does not list a budgeted amount as the goal is to request proposals that will include the applicants' costs associated with completing the project.
- 23. Is your existing vendor bidding on this project? The Town will not know who is submitting proposals until proposals are submitted.
- 24. Are there preferred vendors bidding on this project? The Town does not have a preferred list of vendors for this project.

- 29. Is there a preference for which technology is used in the redesign or will that be left up to the vendor? That will be left up to the vendor.

- 34. What are your needs for an employee intranet, and how many employees do you anticipate using this? Roughly, the Town has 365-380 employees.
- 35. Do you have a CMS preference? We do not have a CMS preference.
- 36. Who would you like to handle the content load? After the initial redesign of the website, staff will handle the content load.
- 37. How much content will migrate from the current site? Also, how much content do you anticipate needing to be developed? All content will need to migrate from our current site.
- 38. What are you currently using for the external online payment software, and are you looking to change this? We use STRIPE, but we are open to other gateways.
