SUBMIT OFFER BY (OPENING DATE) AND TIME REMAINS THE SAME.

Q1: Need confirm if we should provide a proposal for the ladders in this submittal?

A1: Specifications have been revised to read as follows:

Section III.SCOPE OF WORK, MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: The system will be bolted on easily to a standard fixed OSHA approved ladder provided by the District. Specifications do not require vendor to provide the ladder.

Bolt on system that easily attaches to OSHA standard fixed ladder provided by the District.

Q2: I wanted to make you aware that pursuant to the new OSHA standards that has rolled out, it will be required that you have safety guardrails around each hatch door opening to prevent workers from falling into the open hole when the hatch door is open. Would you want a proposal for this in the proposal as well?

A2: No. No change to specifications.
