## **Ouestions and Clarifications:**

I have summarized the questions we have received in regards to RFP 18-007-04. Included with addendum is historical information for both the International Health Insurance Plan and Secondary Supplemental Coverage for Athletes plan. Please review all material. If there are additional questions, please submit them no later than Wednesday May 30<sup>th</sup> at 5pm.

- 1. Historical Information for International Student Health insurance and secondary supplemental coverage:
  - Provided as Attachments to Addendum 2- (9) nine total attachments.
- 2. What kind of coverage do you need regarding "Secondary Supplemental Coverage Options for Athletes"?
  - Answer: The historical policy we have used is an aggregate deductible plan.
- 3. Reason for going out to bid
  Answer: The total cost of services per year comes close to or exceeds the 60K
  threshold for purchasing requirements and we prefer to work with a
  company on a long term basis rather than solicit quotes yearly.
- 4. If we are quoting for Class 1 & Class 2 only would you like intercollegiate athletic coverage included.

Answer: International Athletes should be included in Class 1. Secondary Supplemental Coverage for Athletes should include coverage for international

athletes in the event the international insurance does not cover injuries while participating in athletic events.

- 5. What is the benefit structure you are looking for?
  Answer: The International Health Plan should be consistent with our previous plan, which is provided in the attachments. The Secondary supplemental coverage for athletes has historically been an aggregate deductible plan.
- 6. Can there be a waiting period for pre-existing conditions?

  Answer: please form response proposal based on historical information provided. You may provide a response that has a waiting period for pre-existing conditions.
- 7. We intend to bid only for international students or Study Abroad students, but not for domestic students in the US. In that case, do those plans have to be ACA compliant? Please form response proposal based on historical information provided. To our knowledge, it does not have to be ACA compliant.
