SUBJECT: Addendum #5 to Invitation for Bids # 33203-1, Second Call: 96B Rehabilitation

As a result of inquiries, the following clarifications/changes are provided for your information. Please make all appropriate changes to your bid documents. Note: changes are reflected with original language shown with strike-through and new language is underlined.

- Q1. Can you please confirm that we are allowed to bid this project as we missed the Mandatory Pre-Bid meeting when the project was first bid, I understand this is a rebid and does not have the mandatory meeting, one of our team members was present for the Non-Mandatory Pre-bid meeting held on 08/09/2018. Our name is there on the plan holders list.
- A1: Because the Second Call pre-bid was Non-Mandatory, any interested Contractor may bid on the Project.
- Q2: Can you please clarify under "Agreement between the St. Johns River water management district and sub-contractor" on page number 35 (Item 18A) says that "Contractor shall not sublet, assign or transfer work involving more than 15% of the total cost of work" and item 19 on the same page states that no more than 20% of the total bid can be subcontracted. Which is correct? This project involves several specialty items of work that would normally be subcontracted. If we need to subcontract more than this amount but less than 45% of the total bid amount can we still bid this project?
- A2: The page referred to is from the Sample Agreement provided for reference only. For this project the subcontractor percentage can be increased.
