# SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION ADDENDUM NO. 1

PROJECT: RFP 22-17-001 – Camera System for ECSO

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DATE ISSUED: March 24, 2022

RFP 22-17-001 – Camera System for ECSO dated February 24, 2022 is hereby amended as noted herein: BIDDER TO ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT OF ADDENDUM BY SIGNING ON THE SIGNATURE LINE BELOW AND INCLUDING A COPY WITH SUBMITTED BID. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY, AT THE OWNER'S DISCRETION, SUBJECT THE BIDDER TO DISQUALIFICATION

1) QUESTION: I saw that it is preferred that the new video management system integrate with your current access control system. I may have overlooked it in the RFP, but I didn't see the manufacturer of the current access control system. Is that information you are able to provide?

<u>ANSWER:</u> The current access control system was put in by Accurate Controls based out of Wisconsin.

- 2) <u>QUESTION:</u> Will that integration component between the video management system and the access control system be a mandatory requirement?

  <u>ANSWER:</u> It will not be a mandatory requirement. It would be preferred but if it is not possible it will be fine.
- 3) <u>QUESTION:</u> Does the Sheriff's Office have a minimum response time for service calls, post installation?

<u>ANSWER:</u> We do not currently have a mandatory response time requirement in mind at this time but I would think between 24-72 hours depending on the type of problem.

4) <u>QUESTION:</u> Is the VMS (Video Management Software) open to any manufacture/accepting equivalent substitutes to Vicon or are they requesting explicitly to use Vicon VMS/servers?

ANSWER: We are open to any manufacturer or equivalent substitutes.

- 5) QUESTION: What access control system are you running? ANSWER: Our current access control system is provided by Accurate Controls.
- 6) QUESTION: Could you clarify the number of towers or areas that need camera coverage?

<u>ANSWER:</u> The correct number is 5, not including the two admin stations. Total number of workstations is 7

7) QUESTION: Are all camera's I.P.?

ANSWER: All cameras in the facility are IP cameras

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- 8) QUESTION: How many PTZs do you have?

  ANSWER: 8
- 9) QUESTION: Section 1.2 A: Submission of proposals: Are proposals only submitted via mail or is there an online portal for proposal submission

  ANSWER: There is no online portal. Submittals can be mailed or dropped off in-person at the Effingham County Administrative Complex as stated in the RFP document.
- 10) QUESTION: Section 3.4 Proposal Deadline listed as 11.00am (Eastern Time) Thursday, October 29, 2020, however, Section 1.12 RFP Schedule states Deadline for submission of proposals to be 11:00am (EST) Monday, April 4, 2022. Please clarify ANSWER: The correct deadline is 11:00am on Monday, April 4, 2022.

#### 3.4 CORRECTED PROPOSAL DEADLINE:

The response to the request for proposal must be received by the Effingham County Purchasing Office no later than 11.00am (Eastern Time) Monday, April 4, 2022. Any proposal received after the time and date stipulated will be rejected and returned to the Vendor. The County may, for good and sufficient reason, extend the response deadline, in which case all potential Vendors will receive an addendum setting forth the new date.

- 11) <u>QUESTION:</u> Section 3.11: Selection: Mentions "proven ability to produce deliverables on time and within budget," What is the budget?

  <u>ANSWER:</u> The budget will be determined at a later date.
- 12) <u>QUESTION:</u> The amount of cameras that are listed in the RFP are different from what we are seeing in the drawing. In the drawing we are coming across 181 cameras in total The RFP lists 131.
  - <u>ANSWER:</u> The drawings were just to provide reference for the building layout. 131 is the correct number.
- 13) QUESTION: On page 12 in the Scope of Work it states that there are 5 workstations. In the description on page 16 it states that there are 6.

  ANSWER: The correct number is 5, not including the two admin stations. Total number of workstations is 7.
- 14) <u>QUESTION:</u> Would an additional Site Visit be possible following the Addendum Release if necessary? <u>ANSWER:</u> Yes, schedule permitting.
- 15) QUESTION: Could we receive the full set of PDF Systems Drawings for the Facility? The provided Drawings are missing a section and Match Lines are not lining up.
  ANSWER: This information will be emailed directly to the vendors that attended the mandatory pre-proposal conference.
- 16) QUESTION: Are new PoE Switches to be Layer 2 or Layer 3 Switches?

  ANSWER: Current switches are Layer3 but are being used as Layer2 switches.
- 17) QUESTION: Do the new PoE Switches need to be Stackable?

  ANSWER: Not required.

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18) QUESTION: Do the new PoE Switches need to have 10gig Station Ports or 10gig Uplink?

ANSWER: 10gig Uplink

19) QUESTION: From the walkthrough, Cameras are currently in the Violent Cell and Holding Cell in the Intake/ Processing Area but are not shown on the Drawings provided thus far – do these need to be included in the replacement?

ANSWER: Yes

- 20) QUESTION: RFP Document states (5) Officer Stations on Page 12 but reference (6) Officer Stations on Page 16 please confirm the amount of Stations to be replaced.
  ANSWER: The correct number is 5, not including the two admin stations. Total number of workstations is 7
- 21) QUESTION: Do new Patch Cables from the Patch Panels to the new PoE Switches need to be a specific color?
  ANSWER: No.
- 22) QUESTION: Is there any existing Surge Protection in place for Outdoor Cameras and also inside the MDF/ IDF's?
  ANSWER: Surge protection for equipment but not currently on individual cameras.
- 23) **QUESTION:** Does the system need to include video analytics? **ANSWER:** Preferred but not required
- 24) <u>QUESTION:</u> Do these need to tie in with the Motorola radios? Auto alerts? ANSWER: It is not a requirement
- 25) QUESTION: For the 60 days' retention, does it need to be continuous? ANSWER: Yes.
- 26) QUESTION: Can we quote NDAA compliant products? or is it necessary for the manufacture to be a US based company? or does the product need to be assembled in the united states to comply with the request?

  ANSWER: Yes.
- 27) QUESTION: Will we have access to the Developer file currently in place?ANSWER: We will provide access to whatever is need upon acceptance of bid
- 28) QUESTION: In the RFP, are we swapping any of the touch screen units Or if not, can we have specs on the existing units?
  ANSWER: We would like the 5 officer stations to include new monitors. No smaller than 24". Touch screen not needed.
- 29) <u>QUESTION:</u> Are we including any additional access control or integration licenses needed on our portion of the proposal?

  <u>ANSWER:</u> No.

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30) QUESTION: What is the current HMI used at the facility? In this bid are they approving replacement if needed?

ANSWER: Mouse. Yes.

31) <u>QUESTION:</u> With the email notification and remote viewing capabilities included in the scope of work, County IT will need to be involved with setting up the network routing on the County switches. Upon the project being awarded, is the County willing to have coordination meetings to discuss scope of this work?

<u>ANSWER:</u> Yes

32) <u>QUESTION:</u> For email notifications to work the system will need to be able to access an email server. The owner will be responsible for giving the credentials and network route to see the email server. Upon the project being awarded, is the County willing to have coordination meetings to discuss scope of this work?

ANSWER: Yes

33) <u>QUESTION:</u> For remote connection, the new VMS server(s) will require an outside internet connection. The owner is responsible to provide this connection. Upon the project being awarded, is the County willing to have coordination meetings to discuss scope of this work?

ANSWER: Yes.

34) <u>QUESTION:</u> Attachment A does not have any lines provided for onsite installation labor, contractor Programming/ Engineering labor, or Project management labor. How does the county want this shown?

ANSWER: An amended Attachment A will be included as part of this Addendum.

- 35) QUESTION: Attachment A item #3 has a quantity of 6 officer stations. The scope of work and the current system specs have 5 listed. What is the correct amount to submit?

  ANSWER: The correct number is 5, not including the two admin stations. Total number of workstations is 7
- 36) QUESTION: It is not detailed on what frame rates and recording type is required for the system. Please specify so all submissions are comparable to each other. i.e. 15 Images per second on continuous recording, or X amount of images per second on motion recording and motion will be based on x amount of hours in the day.

  ANSWER: Minimum 15 frames/second, with the ability to go to 30.
- 37) <u>QUESTION:</u> Pages X1.01 and X1.04 have notes adding door controls and conduits. Are these left over from the original build plans or are these really being added to the system?

<u>ANSWER:</u> Those are original build plans meant to be used on as a reference for building layout.

38) QUESTION: Can the owner specify exact camera locations that require audio recording? There aren't any obvious camera locations at the officer stations.
ANSWER: Cameras that require audio will be noted on camera layout maps to be uploaded.
