This addendum is being published to respond to questions asked by a potential proposer regarding the above-referenced Request for Proposals. This addendum becomes a part of the Contract Document and modifies the original specifications as noted.

**Question 1:** Is there a current charge to the residents for the TV's, CRT's or any other e-waste collected?

Response: The City does not impose a fee for electronics for which the City recycles. Electronics that are not recycled and end up being sent to the landfill do incur a dumping fee at \$50/ton (i.e. Cabinet Televisions, etc.)

**Question 2:** Can you share what is being payed current vendor for pickups?

Response: Current Contract pricing:

Amount per pound Contractor will pay, if any, to the City for recyclables listed below:

Complete Computers, Laptops	\$ .05/lb. CPU / \$.54 Laptop
Incomplete Computers, Laptops	Free CPU / \$.40/lb. Laptop
Flat Screen Monitors	\$.05/lb. unbroken screen

Cost to the City, if any, per pound for removal and recycling of the recyclables listed below:

Monitors	\$.39/lb.
Flat Screen Monitors	\$.20/lb. broken screen
Miscellaneous Mice, Key Board, Printers, Scanners	\$.35/lb.
Miscellaneous Electronics: cell phones, game boards, radios, tuners, turntables, etc.	\$.35/lb.

Cost to the City, if any, per pound, for television removal and recycling:

Televisions	\$.39/lb.
Flat Screen Televisions	\$.39/lb.
Wooden cabinet and projection televisions	\$.39/lb.
