QUESTIONS

1. Can the County tell us what the allowable work hours will be on this project?
 - a. Daylight to dark is preferred.
2. Does the County intend to use 9.5MM TP1 for the leveling as in prior years?
 - a. No. Type of material to be used will be determined by the engineer.
3. Will the County allow the contractor to use portable advance warning signs on tripods or will the County require the use of post mounted signs?
 - a. Tripod signs are allowed.
4. Will the County require the contractor to pave back to the radius points at side roads and driveways or are we to pave straight through them?
 - a. Pave drives with a lip but some side roads will need to be paved back to the radius.
5. Will the 19MM be used for patching?
 - a. Yes, on Red Oak Flats Road.
6. Will the contractor be allowed to pave the roads that are 16' wide in one (1) pull instead of two (2)?
 - a. Yes.
7. Will the contractor be required to perform any milling on any of the streets listed in the proposal?



- a. Yes, Red Oak Flats Road.
8. There was mention that the 19MM patching would only be on McDonald Road in the pre-bid meeting. If so, what is the depth and spread rate that the patching will be?
 - a. No patching on McDonald Road.
9. Will this be paid as needed or will we get paid for full amount on bid list?
 - a. Pay will be paid by unit prices and for quantity used. No lump sum payment.
10. Will all the patching be at least 7 feet in width?
 - a. Yes.
11. Was there a spread rate for the leveling for each street since it just states as needed in the bid items?
 - a. No more than 55 lbs.
12. There were 4 sets of warning strips on McDonald Road leading to Porter Springs Road stop sign. Will those need to be replaced in kind as there is no bid item for them?
 - a. Rumble strips are being added to the bid item sheet.
13. On the bid schedule you have 19MM Asphalt and on the "Description of work" it is not listed. I am assuming this is for asphalt patching, if so, can you tell me what roads get the 19MM and how much for each road?
 - a. Red Oak Flats Road and estimated at 200 tons.
14. Is the centerline single or double centerline?
 - a. Double yellow on center line and single line on edge lines. Lines will be paid as single lines per line mile.
15. Can you provide a detail and/or better description of what you expect for shoulder construction?
 - a. Shoulder width will vary on each road but the shoulder needs to be a safe shoulder that is at grade with the pavement and sloping away from the road.
16. When do you expect to issue the NTP?
 - a. Soon after the notice of award is given to the successful contractor. Work can begin in early spring.
