Dear Mr. Silvertooth:

Thank you for your recent proposal for the development of a solar farm at the Arkwright Dump site. After careful evaluation of the dump closure methodology, concerns regarding the potential for differential settlement, and the uncertainties regarding site ground water contamination, the City of Spartanburg has decided not to pursue the development of a solar facility at the Arkwright Dump site.

Should your firm have interest in the development of a solar facility at another location and should that facility be able to offer significant community benefit in the form of job creation targeted to low/moderate income individuals, reduced electrical rates for a defined low income population, or creation of a recurring income stream that could be directed to community development or neighborhood revitalization activities that would benefit low/moderate income individuals in Spartanburg, the city would be interested in further discussion.
