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Question:

The spec calls for quoting (9) well cleanings for this contract. On pages 54 to 55 describes the process for cleaning the wells. Is this the exact steps that have to be followed in the well cleaning? If the price per well cleaning include the video inspection, work required to flow test pre and post, primacord blasting, and the actual rehab work as one? Or is the cost to flow test, video inspect, blast separate?

Answer:

Section 4.0 (page 54 to 56) of the Technical Specifications are the specifications regarding the steps and procedures on what is required for a water well cleaning. These are the exact steps and procedures that must be followed for a water well cleaning. The bid price for the water well cleaning shall be based on the assumption of one (1) cleaning cycle per well. This would include all the materials, manhours, equipment, etc. needed to perform that one cleaning cycle. Item 4.5.K.i explains how the contractor would get paid if the City decides to perform more than one cleaning cycle. If more than one cleaning cycle is performed, these additional cleaning cycles will get billed based upon the time and material itemized in Section 5.5 (pg. 64).
