1. What annuals are to be used. How many annuals are to be used. And where are the annuals to be located?
 - A. Annuals are to be planted once per year in April. So to clarify, Twenty (20) Flats of Annual Plants and One Hundred (100) Perennial Plants (Various Sizes & Types, but generally one (1) to three (3) gallon size) shall be planted in an esthetically pleasing manner in locations to be designated/approved by the City. All locations shall be in established beds. City will show contractor where to plant them at signs, around gate entrances, etc.


