- 1. Additional questions asked and the answers are below.
- Please describe the expected parking enforcement functionality; ie, online ticket payment, online permit sales, online appeals, etc.
  - a. WE WOULD LIKE TO HAVE ONLINE TICKET PAYMENT AND ONLINE PERMIT SALES.
- How are parking citations currently issued? If electronically, who is the current vendor and will existing data be migrated to the new system?

- On the enforcement side, will handhelds be utilized for issuing parking citations?
   If so, can you clarify the number needed and additional features expected such as LPR scanning capabilities?

- Are there any other features, expectations or functionality you are expecting from the parking enforcement side other than the integration of Access Control and LPR?
