This addendum is hereby incorporated into the Bid Documents for the project referenced above. The following items are clarifications, corrections, additions, deletions and/or revisions to and shall take precedence over the original documents. Additions are indicated by <u>underlining</u>, deletions are indicated by <u>strikethrough</u>.

1. Answers to Bidders' written questions:

Q1: Is electrical to be capped off or is the Contractor responsible to reconnect?

A1: The electrical is to be capped off and secured on the east end of the wooden boardwalk.

Q2: Is Coquina acceptable for rock revetment?

A2: **Yes.**

Q3: Can alternate companies beside Bellingham be used to supply the gangway?

A3: Yes, provided the gangway supplied by the other manufacturer can be demonstrated as being an equivalent product.

Q4: Will the City provide laydown area?

A4: There is space on Manatee Island near the floating dock that can be used; however it is the Contractors responsibility to secure and restore this area.

Q5: Is HDPE black vinyl piling wrap acceptable in lieu of PVC pile guard?

A5: **Yes.**

- 3. All other terms and conditions remain the same.

The Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this addendum on the Bid Proposal Form.
