Lupton Mill Site Remediation

- 1) Attached is the sign-in sheet that was inadvertently omitted from Addendum 1.
- 2) The attached paragraph is added to Section 01010, Scope of Work.

“Within the first sixty days of the project, the contractor will salvage and set aside three standard stringer wooden pallets of individual bricks for distribution to the neighborhood residents. Each pallet shall be 48” x 40”, with brick stacked in a reasonably tight fashion, approximately 42 inches high. Contractor shall supply pallets. Brick to be salvaged will be single bricks, as nearly intact as possible, selected from the rubble piles currently on-site, and will represent a general sampling of bricks used in the construction of the buildings at the Mill site. No chimney bricks shall be included due to environmental concerns. Brick to be set aside in a location to be selected by the City for use by the City. There is no separate line item for this work. Work to be performed and Payment to be made to Mobilization.”

- 3) A request has been received for the City of Chattanooga to provide the Bid Schedule in electronic format as an Excel spreadsheet. That file is attached with this addendum. The City of Chattanooga provides the attached spreadsheet file in good faith, but no guarantee is made as to the correctness of the calculations prepared. The City of Chattanooga takes no responsibility for the results of the calculations, and/or the loss or gain of any bids in which the spreadsheet is used, and strongly encourages each bidder to double check all calculations on the bid schedule by hand before submitting bids.
- 4) A question has been received from a potential bidder: “We have applied and will be receiving our license in February for TN and would like to bid on this project. When would this project actually start?”

Answer: It a State of Tennessee requirement that license numbers be placed on the outside of the bid envelopes. Any bid envelope that does not contain a valid license number may not legally be opened.
