Q3	Are any of these lights to be replaced in the apartments?
	No.
Q4	Will the new lamps work in the existing tombstones?
	Yes unless the tombstones are damaged.
Q5	Will KCDC revise the pricing page to add a line for replacement of tombstones as needed?
	Yes-see the attached.
Q6	Who offloads and stores the materials?
	KCDC staff will receive, offload and store the materials.
Q7	Is there security outside if we set a storage pod?
	No. Some sights will have cameras.
Q8	Who disposes of the old product as well as packaging materials for the new items?
	The selected vendor may use KCDC's dumpsters except for the old light fixtures/bulbs. These are
	the vendor's responsibility to get offset and properly disposed of in a manner compliant with laws and rules.
Q9	Are elevators available?
	Yes, all sites have elevators and staff will work with you to make them as available as possible.
Q10	Does KCDC want the awarded vendor to do a payback analysis and cost savings report?
	Yes and list each site individually while providing a grand total.
Q11	Are there any bonding requirements?

Q12	Should the fluorescent ballast be removed, from the fixtures?
	No the ballasts are to abandoned in place.

	This is the vendor's responsibility and the vendor will adhere to all applicable regulations.
