

1.) Insurance Requirements / Section 1 / Sub-part B (Previously submitted via email on 2/6/24)

This section requires General Liability coverage of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$3,000,000.00 aggregate.

Would the county accept coverage of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000.00 aggregate? These are typically the standard amounts these types of policies are written for.

The limits are set based on possible exposure, we use State Sovereign Immunity Limits.

2.) Insurance Requirements / Section 1 / Sub-part C (Previously submitted via email on 2/6/24)

This section requires automobile insurance coverage of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$3,000,000.00 aggregate. Does this section apply to personal vehicles?

We will be using personal vehicles for transportation and as such won't be exposing Franklin County or any of its property to any commercial vehicle traffic. **If awarded, we can discuss this with County Counsel. The limits are set based on possible exposure, we use State Sovereign Immunity Limits.**

3.) Will vendors be provided a lay down or staging area, preferably inside the Franklin County Adult Detention Center, to be used to store materials, store tools, and perform minor fabrication? **Yes**
