

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Work to be performed shall consist of As-Needed Maintenance and Construction of Miscellaneous Street and Drainage Projects within the City of Forest Hills by furnishing all material, incidentals, equipment and performing all labor necessary to complete the various maintenance tasks as authorized by the City Manager.

The included PROPOSAL BID TABULATION FORM contains quantities for bid comparison purposes only. The included quantities in no way reflect actual anticipated quantities. Quantities may be increased or decreased as needed by the City Manager.

Miscellaneous Street Maintenance Projects may include but not be limited to:

- 2. <u>Escalation/De-escalation of prices for Asphalt Cement</u>. This escalation/de-escalation clause is provided for the protection of both the Contractor and the City of Forest Hills against sharp increases or decreases in the prices of material. It further provides the Contractor with a bidding procedure that is of less risk than would otherwise exist.

The base price of bituminous asphalt on the date of the bid opening shall be established using the Tennessee Department of Transportation's Monthly Bituminous Price Index. The "Monthly Price Index" for July 2024 is \$642.73. Any fluctuation of the base price, up or down, greater than five percent (5%) will result in a Change Order of those items affected by the fluctuation. The Change Order will reflect the actual increase or decrease of the base price for asphalt.

The asphalt content for bituminous plant mix base material and asphaltic concrete surface material shall be established using the job mix formula submitted by the Contractor.

- 3. <u>Maintenance of Traffic</u>. The maintenance of traffic shall be paid for under item 712-XX. The contractor will notify the City Manager three (3) days in advance of lane closures or total road closures for the notification of emergency service providers.
- 4. <u>Street Paving / Repair</u>. Areas of undercutting, patching and partial overlay will be determined in the field by the engineer. The existing pavement surface shall be thoroughly cleaned of all dirt and loose particles prior to the application of tack coat. All material shall be removed and disposed of by the Contractor. Joints and cracks shall be cleaned of dirt and vegetation growth. Tack coat shall be applied prior to overlay at a rate of 0.10 gallon per square yard. No additional compensation will be provided for pavement preparation; the cost shall be included in the prices bid.
