 - <u>This is a Prevailing Wage (PW) solicitation:</u> The wage determination incorporated into the bid solicitation and related contract award establishes the wages rates and fringe benefit rates which DOLI has determined to be prevailing in a given area for a particular type of construction. The Contractor shall be required to pay wages in compliance with the pw determination and submit certified wage report to the County on monthly basis.

We suggest that all bidders review the sample contract attached to the solicitation as early as possible, so no time is lost after the award.

- Tomeka turned over the meeting to the Project Officer for an overview of the Scope of Work. Project Officer explained the project and highlighted the work to be done.

sediment control, bridge installation, walkways, signage, landscaping, and all other work shown, described, and required by the Contract Documents".
