Addendum Number 01 is issued to provide changes and/or clarifications to the questions asked on the above referenced bid. Date, Time, and Location of submitting this bid remains unchanged.

General:

Questions and responses offered at the Pre-Bid Meeting held August 10, 2022, at 2:00 PM.

Question 1 – In regard to the six-inch (6") concrete for ramp landings who will be responsible for determination of the potential for vehicle loading?

Response 1 – The response provided at the Pre-Bid Meeting was only partially correct. All ramp landings except those with landings protected by standup curb in front of the landing around the radius shall be six-inch (6") thick. Landings protected by the six-inch (6") standup curb shall be four-inch (4") thick concrete. In example: the four (4) proposed ramps at each corner of the 3^{rd} Street/New York Avenue intersection contain landings protected by six-inch (6") standup curb; so the landings on these ramps are four-inches (4") in thickness.

Question 2 – May Tack Coat be used in lieu of Prime Coat?

Response 2 – This substitution will be acceptable.

Question 3 – Will an Engineer stamped, and sealed traffic control plan be required on this project?

Response 3 – A stamped and sealed traffic control plan will not be required on this project, but that does not relieve the Contractor of their responsibilities regarding development, implementation, and maintaining of both the plan and traffic control devices.

Question 4 – Has a Staging Area been identified on this project?

Response 4 – No Staging Area(s) has been identified for this project. Potential staging areas shall be the responsibility of the Contractor.

Question 5 – How will the removal of subgrade be handled at curbs, driveways, etc?

Response 5 – Removal of subgrade, if necessary, shall be considered incidental to the item being removed. Removed subgrade material may also be used in areas where backfill material may be required for the construction of proposed sidewalks.

Question 6 – Has a designated concrete disposal area been provided on this project?

Response 6 – The Contractor will be responsible for the removal, haul, and disposal of concrete materials.
