




# Disaster Debris Removal Bid Questions Addendum

Do we need to submit a bid bond? **If there is no language in the bid package for a bid bond, one is not required.**

Our firm is interested to know if there is a Debris Monitoring solicitation that will accompany the Debris Removal solicitation, or if there any plans for one to be released in the future. **The Town has a debris monitoring form already in place with Tetra Tech.**

Is permanent binding acceptable? **Yes**

The Bid Submittal Instructions on page 5 instruct vendors to submit 1 copy of the proposal. **Please submit one original and one copy**

Page 5 of the ITB states the contract term is for 5 years, with (2) 1-year renewal terms. Page 7, #10-11 state the contract term is for 3 years, with (3) 1-year renewal terms. **The intent was for five years and two one-year renewals.**

Are bidders required to bid on all of the scopes within the ITB, or are partial awards a possibility? **No partial bids will be considered.**

Does the entire RFP need to be included in our proposal submittal? **No**

P.41 asks for our SC Sales Tax Number. **Yes**

The RFP states that business licenses and insurance specifications will be required for both the contractor and subcontractor. **Yes, business licenses and insurance will be required post award.**

Are Tipping Fees a pass through expense? **Yes, the landfill should not charge tipping fees. If so, they will be a pass through expense.**

Does the Town have any established debris management sites? **At the moment, the Town has a 3-acre transfer station. The Town is working to have a 30-acre site ready by this fall.**

Does the Town have a Debris Monitoring Contract in place? **Yes, with Tetra Tech**

How does the Town define burnable and non-burnable debris? **Burnable is vegetation only**

Due to the fact that the City may not activate a contract in the 5 year specified period or for other unforeseen reasons, it may not be doable for us to require all of our potential subcontractors to obtain a

business license for the City by the submittal date. Will you please suspend that required submittal information (or) maybe have it submitted if awarded the Contract? **Insurance and business license for all sub contractors will be required post award, but before an event activation.**
