Questions and Answers

- 1. Can you please provide the dates of clearing and any chemicals used?

 The County has solicited quotes to spot spray the exotics that are within the mulched area, and anticipates this work to be completed within the next 30 days.
- 2. Please confirm that the exotics within the planting areas be maintained up until the scheduled planting?
 - Exotics will be treated either by County staff or by a licensed contractor.
- 3. Will exotics be maintained after planting? If this is done by others than the Contractor, who will be the responsible party if applied herbicides damage planted material during exotics maintenance?

 Similar work has been completed on the neighboring Dusk Head island and there has not been an issue with non-target application of herbicide, and/or loss of planted vegetation.
- **4.** Is there an identified staging area with boat ramp or is this up to the Contractor to identify? **Mobilization is the responsibility of the Contractor.**
- 5. Will substitutions of similar native species be accepted?
 The County prefers to have the plant species identified installed. In the event that there is a

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demonstrated availability issue, substitutions may be included in the bid (with a note describing rationale).

6. Where is the nearest freshwater source? Does the staging area or boat ramp have a freshwater source?

There is an artesian well on Earman Island on the SW side of the island. As stated during the prebid site review, the water from this well has not been tested to verify salinity or any other parameters. The boat ramp is owned by the City of Vero beach, the Contractor may contact the City to determine availability of water.

7. Can you confirm that per the specifications, the 6-month maintenance period is to be included in the bid price?

Yes.

- 8. Is the establishment period warranty 1:1 replacement by the 6th month?

 Yes, assuming that the size and species of re-planted material remains the same.
- 9. The common and scientific names for Seacoast stumpweed (*Iva imbica*) do not match. Is this meant to be dune elder (*Iva imbricate*)?

 Yes.
- Dune mistflower (*Ageratum maritimum*) is a variety native to Mexico and common/scientific names do not match. Should this be the Florida variety Ageratum littorale?

 Yes.
