This addendum is being published to answer questions from potential bidders and becomes a part of the Contract Document and modifies the original specifications as noted.

Question #1: I wanted to clarify in these RFQ they ask for the proof of "Pesticide Applicator Certification" but neither ask for a Pesticide Charter. Are you all requiring the bidder to have a licensed person with a pesticide charter for the company as well, or just a qualified pesticide applicator that will work under the City of Knoxville charter and City of Knoxville Licensed Supervisor?

<u>Response:</u> The successful proposer will be required to have a Pesticide Charter along with a Pesticide Applicator Certification.

Question #2: Will the landscaping beds and shrubbery be at a maintenance level at the time the contract begins?

<u>Response</u>: The City anticipates that any landscaping areas which are out of compliance with the stated specifications will require little additional effort to return them to a maintenance level and the majority of the sites should still be within a maintenance level.
