**Question 1:** Are there any restroom facilities at the site? **No, the vendor is responsible for providing a porta-john or porta-potty for their staff and this project.**

**Question 2:** Will water be provided? **Yes there will be water provided to an outside connection.**

**Question 3:** Will there be a city employee on-site overseeing the project? **Yes, the City will have an employee from the inspections department rotating through periodically.**

**Question 4:** What times can we access the building? **The times of access will be 7:00 am through 10:00 pm weekdays and weekends.**

**Question 5:** Will land grading be needed for this project? **Although the RFP has that in its requirements, this will not be required for this RFP.**

**Question 6:** Will power be provided? **Yes, the City will provide temporary power for this project.**

**Question 7:** Is parking available? **Yes, there is parking available in the parking lot on-site and also the gravel lot adjacent to the site.**

**Question 8:** If I did not attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting, can I bid on the project? **You can bid on the project but, since this was a mandatory pre-bid it will automatically disqualify the bid.**

**Question 9:** In the crawlspace, the soil has been impacted, do we need to vacuum the obvious impacted soil or do we remove all of the soil? **If the soil is contaminated, yes it needs to be removed.**

**Question 10:** Does the contractor need to contract out air monitoring/clearance sampling? **The bid should include everything that is needed and follow all rules and regulations to complete abatement in order give a clean building for demolition.**
