Question 1: Are there any restroom facilities at the site? No, the vendor is responsible for providing a porta-john or porta-potty for their staff and this project.

Question 2: Will water be provided? Yes there will be water provided to an outside connection.

Question 3: Will there be a city employee on-site overseeing the project? Yes, the City will have an employee from the inspections department rotating through periodically.

Question 4: What times can we access the building? The times of access will be 7:00 am through 10:00 pm weekdays and weekends.

Question 5: Will land grading be needed for this project? Although the RFP has that in its requirements, this will not be required for this RFP.
