“REIDS RD/PONDER PINE RD UNPAVED ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT”

RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS FROM BIDDERS

Question #1: Morgan County prohibits right turns onto 7 Island Rd exiting the Martin Marietta Quarry. The distance to the project site via I-20 is greater than utilizing 7 Island Rd. Can Putnam County ask Morgan County to allow right turns out of the Quarry?

Question #2: Where is the closest fire hydrant?

County Response: Putnam County High School on SR 441

Question #3: There will be excess soil from the project construction. Will the contractor be required to haul-off this material and if so, does the county have a location it can be placed?

County Response: The County will pick-up the soil from the project site. Coordination between the county and contractor will occur with the county project engineer as grading takes place.

Question #4: There are no existing or finished elevations provided for the majority of the roadway plans for this project. Can the county provide either existing/finished contours or cross sections for this project?

The County chose not to shoot elevations on the entire project considering the minimal grade changes, lack of significant drainage issues and overall intent of this unpaved road project.
