- A question was asked about the City's definition of #1 Heavy Melt, #1 Solid Brass, #1 Scrap Copper.

The #1 designation is being used to form a basis for your bid differential. The current scrap located at the City's Water Department and Collections Department is somewhat typical of our scrap. Bidders are able to offer whatever Fixed Differential they determine to be in their best interest and the City will evaluate the bids received according to the standard of highest (since this is for the sale of scrap) and best as pertaining to the best interest of the City.
