9. **Question** – RFP Page 5, Responder shall provide remote alert notification activation devices (1410) to be worn by all faculty/ staff with non-cellular/non-Wi-Fi ability. Could the notification devices use cellular or wi-fi as secondary means of communication?

Answer: Yes

10. **Question** – Is Sullivan County Department of Education using grant funds for this project? If yes, which one?

Answer: Yes partially. Grant funds to be used are Public Schools Security Grant

11. **Question** – What is Sullivan County Department of Education Budget for this project?

Answer: Budget has not been set.

12. **Question** – Is Sullivan County Department of Education looking for software and wearable devices? Or wearable devices only?

Answer: We are looking for both that interact with one another.

13. Question – RFP Requirement: Responder shall provide remote alert notification activation devices (1410) to be worn by all faculty/ staff with non-cellular/non-Wi-Fi ability to activate each level of emergency alert per Sullivan County Department of Education Standard Response Protocol. This device will be multi-functional alert system that allows faculty/ staff to request support for medical emergency and non-emergency related assistance in addition to a separate function that allows faculty/staff to lockdown. When this device is activated by the incident reporter, device location within the facility shall be communicated and displayed automatically on administrator (and others directed by the Sullivan County Department of Education Emergency Management Representative or designee) computer screens, devices, and/or cell phone/mobile

application. The incident severity shall be defined/ displayed similarly and/or the level of the crisis event shall be communicated similarly. The devices shall work at each site.

Question: How many individuals will need wearable devices? Is it a requirement that the device can be used without leveraging WiFi?

Answer: 1410 wearable devices needed; preferably yes

14. **Question** – RFP Requirement: Include geographic configuration of incident/ emergency management strobes at multiple locations as required to provide visibility of the strobes in the entire facility with integrated reporting across building, areas, and exterior locations. Ouestion: Are emergency management strobes a requirement?

Answer: Preferable, but not required

15. **Question** – RFP Requirement: Have configured redundancy or functionality that is not dependent on existing power or network capability.

Question: Is Sullivan County Department of Education looking for a solution that can function with/without WiFi and/or with/without power?

Answer: Preferably a system that can function without WiFi, not necessary to operate without power

16.Question – RFP Requirement: All necessary hardware, cabling interconnects, programming, etc. to have a complete and fully functional system at the end of the project.

Question: Is Sullivan Department of Education looking for a solution that works out of the box? Are you asking if it automatically connects to the PSAP/ECC?

Answer: YES

17. **Question** – RFP Requirement: Documentation, training, and on-going support shall include on-site training, scheduled webinars, video and online tutorials; to include unlimited vendor provided system support.
