



ADDENDUM # 2

Camera Installation and On-Call IT Services, LEC

This addendum is being issued to address questions posed since the solicitation was originally issued.

All contents of this addendum shall be incorporated into the solicitation documents and the ensuing contract with the awarded Contractor. It is the Contractor's responsibility to ensure their receipt of all addenda, and to clearly acknowledge all addenda within their initial bid response. Acknowledgement may be confirmed by inclusion of a signed copy of this addendum with the initial bid response. Failure of a Contractor to acknowledge each addendum may prevent the bid from being considered for award and deem the Contractor as non-responsive. Addendum, revised forms and documents attached hereto shall not be altered and attached to bid submittals in their original format.

CLARIFICATION OF STATEMENTS

1. Q&A

Q 1. What are the specifications for the cameras?
A 1. The Town is requesting at least 3 MP IP-based camera. For areas requiring an 180 degree style camera, at least 3 MP per lens or any other recommendations by the vendor.
Q 2. What is the current video system used by the Town?
A 2. The Town currently uses DW Spectrum for our camera system at the Law Enforcement Center. We are comfortable with this software but are willing to look at other options.
Q 3. What is the intended use of the camera system?
A 3. The cameras would be used for public safety in our parks, open spaces, and walking trails.
Q 4. Is there an existing NVR system for the Public Works office?
A 4. The Town does not currently have an NVR system in place. This would be a new system. We desire to have 15 days of storage available.
Q 5. What type of system would be preferred?
A 5. The Town prefers a point to point system for both locations. The only conduit for cabling that would be required is for the Dog Park area due to tree growth. The conduit will run from the exterior of the building to a pole on the side of the Dog Park where the camera would be mounted.
Q 6. Will the Town provide the poles for the cameras and power to those locations?
A 6. The poles for mounting the cameras and the power for the equipment will be provided by the Town.

2. **Bid Responses**

The time to submit bids shall be extended until November 14, 2018. The time and method of delivery shall remain the same.

3. **Public Opening of Proposals**

The time for the public opening of the proposals shall be extended until November 14, 2018. The time and location shall remain the same.

All prospective Respondents are reminded and hereby instructed not to contact any member of the Town of Bluffton Council, Town Manager or Town of Bluffton staff members, other than the noted contact person OR the Town's Purchasing Administrator regarding this IFB or their response at any time during the solicitation and award process. Any such contact shall be cause for rejection of your submittal.
