Question 1: Is design and construction funded solely from the AFP Grant awarded or have additional funds been allocated for the project? No, the City of Wilson is matching \$300,000

Question 2: Can the City disclose the projected construction budget? There are several aspects that the City is utilizing to complete this project which include Architectural and Engineering Services (A/E), Purchase of Equipment, Construction, and City provided labor. In order to estimate exact construction costs the budget below will help understand the budgetary constraints that we will need to stay within for this project. This RFQ is for the (A/E) Services qualifications submittal response.

Question 3: Can the City disclose the total project budget? \$700,000 includes construction, purchase of equipment/installation, and engineering services. This RFQ is for A/E. Once a firm is selected based on qualifications for the (A/E) services, the other portions will be bid separately.

Question 4: Do the picnic tables need to be regular or kid height? The city will be purchasing, providing, and installing picnic tables and shade canopies.

Question 5: Site prep and utilities - what does that entail? This isn't detailed on the documents. General site prep, the area is very small and will require a skid steer and mini ex. This will be bid after a firm is selected and detailed plans are available.

Question 6: We will need water 2in line and how far from water main do we need to come and where is it located? The city will bring the water to the pump station at the City's cost.

Question 7: Electric within 10 feet of splash pad if possible. Where is the closest connection? The city will provide electricity to the pump station at the City's cost.

Question 8: Do you have a preference on the recirculating equipment location? Yes, the recirculating system location will be adjacent to the splash pad.
