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1. How big is the room?
    - a. 8x8
  2. How many microphones?
    - a. 1
  3. Do you want both rooms on 1 server?
    - a. Per the RFP, there will be 2 servers on a single platform for one room. The second room will not be considered at this time.
  4. Is the support and maintenance negotiable?
    - a. Possibly, but the expectation is to have immediate access to support and repair. The expectation for maintenance is that there be a minimum of 5 years included in pricing and ongoing maintenance of any software used.
  5. Can the push button be a switch instead of a push button?
    - a. Yes
  6. Does the indicator have to blink?
    - a. Not necessarily but has to light up and catch the attention of anyone walking by so they will know the room is in use.
  7. Do you want there to be an indicator for both rooms?
    - a. There will need to be an indicator for one room as the other room is not being done at this time.
  8. Banned list for cameras- federal ban? 3MP Hikevision and Dahua? Are ours on the list?
    - a. No camera that is on the banned list is to be used for this project.
  9. The touchscreen referenced in the RFP- is this for the outside of the interview room-this would be where the controls are for starting and stopping?
    - a. There is no need for a touchscreen outside the door. It can be a mechanical startup (switch) and stop with

illuminated “in use” notification.

10. The RFP says the footage needs to be “watermarked” or admissible in court but it also references the ability to edit and cut the footage. These seem contradictory.
  - a. The footage is required to be watermarked (admissible in court) so there will be no need to have the ability to edit footage on the start/stop recording system. This ability was previously considered for a continuous recording system and is no longer applicable.
11. Cisco data switch model number info?
  - a. There should currently be enough ports for the desired installation but if a new switch is needed the model number is Cisco C9300, at least a 24 port switch POE.
12. Software needs the functionality of transferring/downloading the footage from all stations-not just from the base station in the closet.
13. The RFP refers to remote viewing. Is this all in-network or outside the network?
  - a. Remote viewing is referring to viewing at different stations/offices all located on the same network. There will be no need for viewing off network.
