SUBJECT: Addendum #4 to Invitation for Bids # 36060, Lake Apopka Duda Property Water Storage Improvements

As a result of inquiries, the following clarifications/changes are provided for your information. Please make all appropriate changes to your bid documents. Note: changes are reflected with original language shown with strike-through and new language is underlined.

- Q1: Apopka Wildlife Drive & Trail are open from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and federal holidays. Are we allowed to work and receive materials on Fridays?
A1: Yes. See A10 of Addendum #2. Note, the District anticipates the contractor will access the site from the entrance near McDonald Canal Boat Ramp and not from the Apopka Wildlife Drive.
- Q2: Are we allowed to work on weekends on areas that are closed to the public?
A2: Yes, however, work activities that require District staff to inspect such work may not occur on weekends unless authorized ahead of time.
- Q3: How will the CY totals be calculated on pay items 4 & 5? If we are using cross-sections before and after, what is the minimum interval for cross-sections for the pay apps?
A3: CY totals will be calculated by record of material deliveries/ load tickets.
- Q4: Are staging and laydown yard available, and where?
A4: Yes, there is some room within the upland areas near the Duda West Road/ Marsh Rabbit Road intersection, at the north and south ends of the North-South Road, and near the central intersection. Other small upland areas may be available along the sides of each road. In either case, the contractor must leave enough room to allow District vehicles and other District contractors to pass on all roads. Contractor may need to construct both turn-arounds and additional staging areas.
- Q5: On pay item #3 (Levee and Road Repair): Is the contractor expected to perform road maintenance work once a month or only a few times when issues arise?
A5: As needed when issues arise.
- Q6: If needed, is the District going to provide and pay for a gator trapper?
A6: No.
