RE: Addendum 1, ITB# 23-08-001 Road Striping Program

The following changes are to be incorporated into the solicitation documents dated **August 11**, **2022.** All those receiving this addendum should modify their documents to show the below described changes.

- 1. Answers to questions received prior to the deadline of 5:00 pm on August 19, 2022.
- 2. UPDATED Cost Schedule

1. Answers to questions received prior to the deadline of 5:00 pm on August 19, 2022.

**Q1**: Will a bid bond be required? **A1:** A bid bond is not required.

- **Q2:** Will the County Clip/Blade the edges of the roadway when required?
- A2: Yes, the County will clip and sweep the roads prior to striping.
- **Q3:** The Crosswalks are measured by "LF" but is this the LF (or walking feet) of the actual crosswalk or LF of 8" striping in the crosswalk?
- A3: The striping will be measured by the linear feet of 8" striping.
- **Q4:** Will the 4" paint pay item be used for temporary striping and the 5" paint item for final striping?
- A4: This contract will not require temporary striping. Please see updated cost schedule. Line items for 4" striping have been removed.

**Q5:** The Rumble strips are listed as "short" what does the county mean by this? **A5:** The rumble strips will be low profile.

- **Q6:** The rumble strips are measured by EA. These are typically installed as a set of 3 so will 1 EA be a set of three or would that be measured as 3 EA?
- A6: The rumble strips will be measured as each. Not as a set of 3.
- **Q7:** What is the County's intention for the Traffic Control/Mobilization/Bond pay item? Will this lump sum be added to each purchase order or is this a one-time Lump sum to be added to each year renewable year?
- **A7:** This will be included in each year's contract.
- **Q8:** If needed, will Oconee County be willing to remove heavy debris from the roadway such as clipping grass/dirt from the edges of the roads? A motor grader and other heavy equipment would be needed for this. The Scope sounds like the contractor will be responsible for all preparation. I just need clarification.
- **A8:** Please refer to question 2.
- **Q9:** On the paint portion line items, What kind of paint is the line item referencing? Georgia High Build Paint or Georgia Regular Paint?
- A9: This will be Georgia Regular Paint.
